Central Office Update (Enc.)

- Dr. Hopson said Ms. Fisk will update us on the budget. MARS is on board as the consultant mandated by DESE. We have 80% of the information collected. They will be visiting in fall and a draft report should be out in Feburary. Mr. Garivaltis is our new pupil services replacement. We are looking for a new history teacher in the high school.
- Secretaries have a new representative and are setting up initial dates for negotiations.

### D. Business Manager

- Ms. Fisk said the Governor has signed the final budget and DESE has put out numbers. They left the options to us. We could go to the towns and ask for more money or make the changes. No one can have an increase in their assessments. We could leave it that far out of balance but she doesn't feel compfortable with that. She increased earned interest, Medicaid receipts, and Charter reimbursements. Every town will receive new assessments. All towns will have a decrease except for Russell, they are at 0%. School committee does not have to vote because we are not using E & D.
- Dr. Hopson said minimum contribution is down by \$55,000. Ms. Fisk went through and it left us a balance of \$33,000. She increased revenue so we have a balanced budget at this point.
